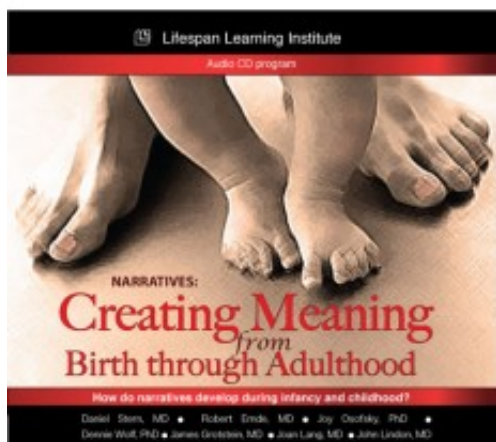


Creating Meaning from Birth Through Adulthood
